About Us:

West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited (A Wholly Owned Company of Govt. of West Bengal) was incorporated in April 2012 under Companies Act 1956 as a wholly owned company of the Government of West Bengal under Public Works Department. West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited has its registered office at Kolkata, West Bengal. It has an authorized capital of Rs. 2000 Crs (Rupees Two thousand crores only) and paid-up capital of Rs. 818 Crs (Rupees Eight Hundred and Eighteen crores only) divided into 81,80,000 equity shares of Rs. 1000.00 each. Being a Government company, all the shares are held by the Government of West Bengal.

The Corporation acts as a nodal organization for development, up-gradation and maintenance of State Highways as part of this core network. The present Government of West Bengal contemplated for creation of a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) to upgrade and maintain core road network in the district comprising of State Highways and adopt Public Private Partnership as an instrument of delivery of better roads where private / public operator shall be allowed to levy user charge or toll for a certain period of time.

Mission:

- To promote core road network primarily comprising of state highways in state of West Bengal by taking up Road Works, Bridges, under-pass , ROBs etc., and to improve road network by taking up construction, widening / strengthening and improvement/up-gradation of state highways and bridges and to implement long term maintenance regime for state highways and bridges.
- To develop, upgrade and maintain important roads connecting State Highways and those roads handed over to corporation by Government from time to time.
- To promote and encourage Private Sector Participation in Highway Sector at state level by acting as a nodal organization of the state in creating an enabling environment to attract private capital in highway sector .
- To construct, reconstruct, erect, build remodel, repair, reclaim, demolish, develop, improve, operate and maintain the roads, bridges, culverts, embankment, sideways, subways, flyovers, tunnels, railroads, multi - modal transport systems and infrastructure, models and complexes for improvement of state highway network of West Bengal .

- To identify potential schemes for implementation under PPP (i.e. BOT, BOT-Annuity or any other evolving modes of PPP) consistent with policy of the Government of India and Government of West Bengal and to appoint any Consultant in Government or Private sector in order to collect data and information, to carry out detail survey and investigation in order to prepare feasibility report and detailed estimate of project as well as assess and report economic and financial viability of the project in PPP mode.
- To act as the nodal Bidder of the State Government for executing roads and allied infrastructure projects or for objects as envisaged in above clause under public - private or joint venture basis through selection of concessionaire in a transparent manner for construction, operation and maintenance of specified highways and bridges in PPP mode.
- To act as nodal organization on behalf of state of West Bengal to prepare Feasibility, DPR and other reports for procuring Loans/Aids from External Funding Agencies like ADB , World Bank , JBIC etc. and act as Executing Bidder for such Externally Aided Projects (EAP) on behalf of State of West Bengal .
- To prepare Road Information System and Road Management System in IT enabled and GIS Platform and develop strategic plans for the state road sector for identification, prioritization and selection of projects based upon economic, social, technical, commercial and environmental parameters.
- To Act as Bidder in connection with infrastructure projects in India or abroad.
- To follow competitive and transparent bidding procedures in procurement of Consultancy Services, Civil works Contract and selection of Concessionaire for PPP Project.

Vision:

The present government of West Bengal contemplated for creation of a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) to upgrade and maintain core road network in the district comprising of state highways and adopt Public Private Partnership as an instrument of delivery of better roads where private / public operator shall be allowed to levy user charge or toll for certain period of time.

Purpose of Tender:

West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited, (A Wholly owned Company of Government of West Bengal) issue Notice Inviting Quotation (NIQ) from reputed and experienced Bidder for **10 Mbps** Internet BW (1:1) Leased Line at HRBC Bhawan, 4th& 5th Floor, Munshi Prem Chand Sarani, Kolkata-700021.

A. Criteria for Eligibility:

- i. The bidder should have been in the business of Internet Leased line connectivity services for at least 5 (five) years.
- ii. The bidder should have implemented similar Internet leased line projects in any of Govt. /Corporation/Statutory Authority/Public sector undertaking etc. in India.
- iii. The bidder should have valid Class “A” ISP License from Government of India.
- iv. The bidding firm/company must be a single company and no consortium is allowed.
- v. Bidder should have relevant ISO certifications.
- vi. The bidder should have direct access to International Internet Gateway in India Peering with Tier-1 ISPs.
- vii. The bidder should have valid Trade License,PAN, VAT,ESI,PF registration Number on the last date of submission of bid.
- viii. The Average annual turnover of the bidder should be more than 10 Lakhs for the last three years.
- ix. The bidder should not have been blacklisted by any Govt. Organization, undertaking, Corporation etc.

B. Contract period:

1. The validity of the contract would be for a period of one year form the actual date of completion of scheduled work as per the scope and acceptance from WBHDCL.
2. The WBHDCL will have option to extend the period of contract by another two years, on year to year basis or a particular period depending on performance and satisfaction of work subject to the approval of competent authority at same rate and terms and condition of LOA.
3. WBHDCL reserve the right for termination of the contract at any time by giving one month written notice, if the services are found unsatisfactory.

C. Scope of Work:

- i. Provision of redundant Internet Bandwidth **10 Mbps**, 1:1 clean (L.L) at HRBC Bhawan, 4th& 5th Floor, Munshi Prem Chand Sarani, Kolkata-700021.
- ii. Supply, installation of necessary hardware as required at site.
- iii. Configuration of above as per WBHDCL requirement.

D. Rates and Taxes:

- i. Rates will be inclusive of all taxes.
- ii. Income Tax and other statutory levies as applicable from time to time will be deducted from the bills.
- iii. Unless otherwise specified in the NIQ, the consultant shall pay all such taxes, duties, fees and other impositions, as may be levied under the Applicable Law and the Authority shall perform such duties in regard to the deduction of such taxes as may be lawfully imposed on it including labour Cess. However, only for service Tax, Bidder shall pay Service Tax at applicable Rates and same shall be reimbursed by the Authority on submission of documentary evidence of such deposit of Service Tax.

E. Payment Terms:

Payment will be released after every 3 months on submission of invoice in favor of West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited along with supporting documents of previous quarter. Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of submission of invoice after necessary checking and scrutiny of the invoice.

F. Tender Fees:

An non-refundable tender fee of Rs 2,000/-(Rupees Two Thousand Only) in the form of Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque of any scheduled commercial bank in favor of West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited payable at Kolkata.

G. Security Deposit:

The bidder shall submit the security deposit @10% of quoted amount, in form of DD/Pay Order drawn from any schedule commercial bank in favor of "West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited" within 7 working days of placement of LOA. The security deposit will be refunded without any interest on termination/expiry of contract.

H. Right of Invocation of Security Deposit:

West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited reserves the right to invoke the Security Deposit at any time during its validity period in the event of failure any sorts of operational complication of ordered service / breach of any terms of this contract.

I. Termination or Cancellation:

WBHDCL reserves the right, at its convenience, to terminate or cancel the whole or any part of the Services by giving one month advance notice thereby if:

- i. The Bidder fails to comply with any of the terms of the order.
- ii. The Bidder becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- iii. Any receiver is appointed for the property owned by the Bidder.
- iv. On breach of confidentiality of information.
- v. On any other valid ground, at the discretion of the Competent Authority.

J. Confidentiality:

The Bidder shall not use confidential information, the name or the logo of WBHDCL except for the purposes of providing the Service as specified under this contract.

The Bidder shall be liable to fully recompense WBHDCL for any loss of revenue arising from breach of confidentiality. WBHDCL reserves the right to adopt legal proceedings, civil or criminal, against the Bidder in relation to a dispute arising out of breach of obligation by the Bidder under this clause.

K. Settlement of Disputes:

i. Amicable Settlement:

The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all disputes arising out of or in connection with this agreement or the interpretation thereof.

In the event of any Dispute between the parties, both Parties may call upon (MD, WBHDCL) and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the bidder for amicable settlement, and upon such reference, the said person shall meet no later than 15 working days from the date of reference to discuss and attempt to amicably resolve the Dispute. If such meeting does not take place within the 15 working days period or the Dispute is not amicably settled within 20 working days of the meeting or the Dispute is no resolved as evidenced by the signing of writing referred to in clause (ii) or such longer period as may be mutually agreed by the parties either party may refer the Dispute to arbitration and conciliation in accordance with the provisions of clause K (iv).

ii. Dispute Resolution:

Any dispute, difference or controversy of whatever nature howsoever arising under or out of or in relation to this Agreement between the parties and so notified in writing by either Party

to the other Party shall in the first instance, be attempted to be resolved amicably in accordance with the conciliation procedure set forth in clause iv.

- iii. The Parties agree to use their best efforts for resolving all disputes arising under or in respect of this Agreement promptly equitably and in good faith and further agree to provide each other with reasonable access during normal business hours to all non-privileged records, information and data pertaining to any Dispute.

iv. Arbitration and Conciliation:

1. Any dispute which is not resolved amicably by conciliation, as provided in clause K(i). Such arbitration shall be held in accordance with the Rules of Arbitration of the International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution, New Delhi or such other rules as may be mutually agreed by the Parties and shall be subject to the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (including any statutory modifications thereof for the time being in force and as may be enacted from time to time) .The venue of such arbitration shall be Kolkata and the language of arbitration proceedings shall be English.
2. There shall be Board of three arbitrators, of whom each party shall select one, and the third arbitrator shall be appointed by the two arbitrators so selected and in the event of disagreement between the two arbitrators, the appointment shall be made in accordance with the Rules.
3. The arbitrators shall make a reasoned award. Any Award made in any arbitration held pursuant to the clause K shall be final and binding on the Parties as from the date it is made and both the parties agree and undertake to carry out such Award without delay.
4. The Bidder and the Service Receiver agree that an Award, any, be enforced against both the parties, as the case may be.
5. The Agreement and the rights and obligations of the Parties shall remain in full force and effect pending the Award in any arbitration proceedings hereunder.

L. Jurisdiction:

- i. Litigation, if any pertaining to this contract will come under the jurisdiction of the courts at Kolkata only.
- ii. All contracts shall be deemed to have been wholly made in Kolkata and all claims there under are payable in Kolkata City and it is the distinct condition of the order that no suit or action for the purpose of enforcing any claim in respect of the order shall be instituted in any Court other than that situated in Kolkata only.

M. Force Majeure:

If at any time, during the continuance of the contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under the contract prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or acts of God (hereinafter referred to a "event"), provided notice of happenings of any such event duly endorsed by the appropriate authorities/chamber of commerce in the country of the Bidder giving notice, is given by party seeking concession to the other as soon as practicable, but within 21 days from the date of

occurrence and termination thereof and satisfies the party adequately of the measures taken by it, neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate the contract, nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such nonperformance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end of ceased to exit and the decision of the WBHDCL shall be final and conclusive provided further that if the performance in whole or in part or any obligation under the contract prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days the WBHDCL may at his option terminate the contract.

N. Fraud and Corrupt Practices:

The Bidders and their respective officers, employees, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the Selection Process. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this NIQ, WBHDCL shall reject a Proposal without being liable in any manner whatsoever to the Bidder, if it determines that the Bidder has, directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice (collectively the “Prohibited Practices”) during the Selection Process, or after the issue of the Notice of Award or the execution of the Contract. In such an event, WBHDCL shall, without prejudice to it’s any other rights or remedies, forfeit and appropriate the Security Deposit.

For the purposes of the Clause above, the following terms shall have the meaning hereinafter respectively assigned to them:

- i. “fraudulent practice” means a misrepresentation or omission of facts or disclosure of incomplete facts, in order to influence the Selection Process;
- ii. “coercive practice” means impairing or harming or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any persons or property to influence any persons participation or action in the Selection Process;
- iii. “undesirable practice” means (i) establishing contact with any person connected with or employed or engaged by WBHDCL with the objective of canvassing, lobbying or in any manner influencing or attempting to influence the Selection Process; or (ii) having a Conflict of Interest;
- iv. “Restrictive practice” means forming a cartel or arriving at any understanding or arrangement among Bidders with the objective of restricting or manipulating a full and fair competition in the Selection Process.

O. Acceptance of LOA:

The successful bidder shall submit written unconditional acceptance of LOA within 7 days from the date of issuance of the same. Submission of conditional acceptance of LOA shall be treated as non-compliance of this clause.

P. Representative of bidders:

The successful bidder is required to nominate one officer exclusively for this project from commencement to completion as as Nodal Officer to be stationed at Kolkata with whom WBHDCL will contact on all matters related to this order. The bidder has to specifically

furnish to WBHDCL, the name, designation, Telephone no including mobile no. email address of such person.

Q. Terms and Conditions:

- i. The Bidder should ensure that the local loop provisioning does not violate regulations as laid by Government of India / TRAI in respect of such links / networks. Bidder will be responsible for making all the payments towards the local loop charges / rentals / WPC charges etc.
- ii. The bidder will be solely responsible for all regulatory and follow up jobs with external agencies for seeking all necessary approvals to meet the project requirements during the project implementation and tenure of the contract.
- iii. The bidder should be capable of providing Internet Leased Line through Wire-line optic Fibre for last mile connectivity.
- iv. The last mile connectivity media should be self -owned & all the Points of Presence (PoP) should be connected on fully owned backbone of the Bidder.
- v. The bidder should be able to provide end-to-end solution including last mile Ethernet/Fast Ethernet based solution on wire-line / wireless network. The Bidder's network should be compatible with Ethernet over SDH.
- vi. The bidder should have fully resilient and self-healing network architecture, on fiber medium, for domestic backbone.
- vii. The bidder should have their own fiber based Pan India Network with STM16/STM64/10Gig backbone connecting different Telecom Circles.
- viii. The bidder should have leased capacity on all the leading cable system existing out of India.
- ix. Bidder to have leased capacity on all undersea cable networks.
- x. Bidder to have access to International Network.
- xi. The bidder should have the capability of increasing / decreasing bandwidth on demand and should be willing to change the bandwidth up or down on demand. The bidder should also be capable of providing higher bandwidth on demand at all locations.
- xii. The bidder should have enough capacity to provide connectivity for all the existing and future locations as and when requested.
- xiii. The bidder should have capability of End to End Managed Services which should include Customer Premise Equipment (CPE) management.
- xiv. The bidder must to provide the minimum service availability of 99.5%. The uptime of the link shall be computed on monthly basis. Detailed If leased line is down or below quoted bandwidth for more than 10 minutes, 1 day bill be deducted and if down for whole day, 2 day bill will be deducted.
- xv. The bidder should have centralized trouble ticketing tool for call logging, monitoring and trouble-shooting purpose.
- xvi. The bidder should have single Toll Free number/Help Desk running on 24*7*365 for all the call logging and status update.
- xvii. The bidder should have well defined capabilities and procedures to track call resolution, progress status and provide the updates to the customer. In addition, the bidder should have well defined management and technical escalation procedures.
- xviii. The bidder should provide Online View access of their network topology, configurations details, Link status, logs etc (like MRTG etc.)
- xix. The bidder should have own Network Operating Center (NOC) with Disaster Recovery (DR) facility in different Seismic Zones for trouble-shooting round the clock to ensure uninterrupted services. The NOC should also possess ISO/ITEL/TL compliant certification. The NOC should work proactively towards network monitoring & management. Address of the NOC and DR sites to be provided.
- xx. The Bidder will do a preventive maintenance once a quarter for upkeep of the systems running and a gap of at least 2 months shall be maintained between two successive such maintenance. The schedule will have to be adhered to strictly by him.
- xxi. The Bidder should provide all operation, service and maintenance (inclusive of hardware) with the quoted amount.
- xxii. The Bidder shall hereby indemnify and will keep us indemnified against all acts of omission or negligence, dishonesty or misconduct of the workmen /staff engaged by you for work at our office / premises and we shall not be liable to pay for any damages or compensation to

such person or to third party. You shall at all times indemnify us against any claim whatsoever which would arise under any status or under any provision of the laws of the land.

- xxiii. WBHDCL will not be responsible for any injury or loss of life of the persons deployed for delivery of stationery items. The Bidder will have proper insurance against any injury or loss of life of the person deployed for providing services on behalf of the bidder.
- xxiv. During the tenure of this Contract period, no extra charges on whatever grounds are to be admitted by us. Rate shall be firm and shall not be subject to any escalation due to any reasons whatsoever.
- xxv. Bidder will be disqualified unless they furnish the particulars and enclose authentic copies of documents as asked for in the form of particulars.
- xxvi. A tender being submitted by a Firm or a Company must be signed by each of the partners thereof and in the event of absence of any of the partners it shall be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so. Certified copies of Registration Certificates, Partnership deed and Power of Attorney shall have to be furnished with the tender is to be considered for acceptance.
- xxvii. Successful bidder shall arrange the necessary way leave/ROW (Right of Way) in connection to the establishment of way of the link. WBHDCL shall neither negotiate nor incur any additional charges towards obtaining way leave (Row) permissions whatsoever.

R. Clarification and Amendment of Bid Documents

- i. Bidder may request a clarification on any clause of the Bid latest by 12:30 Hrs. on 07.03.2017.
- ii. Any request for clarification must be sent in writing or by standard electronic means to the West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited will respond in writing, or by standard electronic means If it is necessary to amend the Bid document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so after following the due procedure.
- iii. At any time before the submission of Proposals, West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited may amend the Bid document by issuing a corrigendum in writing or by standard electronic means. The corrigendum shall be published in web site and will be binding all bidders. To give Bidders reasonable time in which to take an amendment into account in their proposals, West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited may, extend the deadline for the submission of Proposals.
- iv. West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited may also seek clarifications from the Bidder on the content of their Bid during the technical evaluation process. All correspondences for clarifications will be sent to the Bidder. The Bidder is expected to provide the clarifications within the time frame to be specified in the letter. If the Bidder fail to provide any clarifications against such requests, West Bengal Highway Development Corporation Limited will make appropriate assumptions on those points and proceed with the evaluation.

S. Evaluation Criteria:

Order will be placed to the L1 subject to fulfill all the condition mentioned in the NIQ.
